# Life Change Programme

## Year 1 - Overview

Community	Custody
7 delegates over 2 courses	12 delegates over 1 course
4 completed the course	12 completed
50% re-offended	2 have been released 1 has re-offended, 1 still engaging
25% volunteer in crime prevention	8/10 have been given jobs seen as positions of trust
25% secured employment	3 engage by letter, still have special visits
	1 has gained D-Cat
	3 due to be released within 3 months
